RECEIVING: Thursday April 14, 2016 3:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. Clovis Veteran's Memorial Building, 808 4th Street, Clovis, CA 93613. Due to limited space, this show may be juried.

CATEGORIES: This is a themed / open show. You may enter your art in the **THEME CATEGORY "OLD WEST & RODEO"** using any acceptable media from the 7 open categories as long as the subject matter is the Old West, Rodeo or the Western Way of Life. **THE 7 OPEN SUBJECT CATEGORIES ARE Oils, Acrylics, Watercolor, Pastel, Drawing/Graphics, Mixed Media and Sculpture/3-D.** Please note the changes to the following categories.

- Oils and acrylics have been separated into two categories
- Drawing/Graphics covers pencil, charcoal, colored pencil, Prisma-Color, markers, pen/ink and just about any medium that can be used to draw lines on paper.
- Mixed Media art may be entered either in the 3-D category or Mixed Media category. For art to be considered Mixed Media, **all medias** must be **clearly visible**. The proper category will be determined by the show chair at receiving.
- Sculpture/3-D art may include bas-relief, assemblage, collage, 3-D mixed media, encaustic, glass, ceramic, any sculpture mediums such as clay, wood, stone, paper, etc.

ENTRY FEE: \$20.00 for non-members, \$15.00 for CAG members (non-refundable)

RECEPTION/AWARD CEREMONY: Wednesday April 20, 2016 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. Public is welcome. Awards to be given out this night. CAG does not mail out awards; awards must be picked up in person. ***Please be there to accept your award!***

PRIZE MONEY: Cash prizes will be offered for Best of Show, First, Second, Third places. There must be 8 entries in a category for monetary awards. Honorable Mentions will be awarded ribbons. The Mary Krause award is a special award for artwork showing a unique understanding of the principals of art.

ELIGIBILITY: This show is open to all artists 18 years or older; artists under 18 must provide a parent/guardian's signature on the entry form. All painting media, graphics, and sculpture medias are acceptable.

LIABILITY: All entries will be handled with the utmost care and protection, but Clovis Memorial District or the Clovis Art Guild will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any entry whatsoever the cause, before, during or after the exhibits. Artists should carry their own insurance.

EXHIBIT HOURS: Mon – Saturday 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Sunday noon—3:00 p.m. **Artists entering the show should be prepared to sit as host/hostess or furnish a representative for at least 1 — 3-hour segment during the show. Thank You.**

ART PICKUP: Sunday, April 24, 2016 3:00—4:00 pm, at the show location. **Storage of Art Not Picked up is not an option. If you cannot be present during art pickup, please make arrangements for someone else to pick up your art.** Any winning entry may be used for publicity purposes and the front of the 2017 prospectus.

RULES OF EXHIBIT

- Entries in categories that have been combined will be judged against the standards for the original media.
- All entries must have been completed within the last three years. A signed and completed entry form must accompany each work.
- No copies of artwork done partially or totally by commer-

cial printing processes will be accepted. Nor will copies of another's work by using postcards, art books, magazines or other printed material. Due to copyright issues art depicting famous people or celebrities may not be entered without the express written permission of that person.

- No assigned class-work will be accepted. Independent work that has been critiqued by a professional is acceptable as is independent work done in a classroom environment.
- Artists may enter no more than 3 entries per category and no more than 9 entries each. Entries cannot have been shown in consecutive Clovis Art Guild juried shows.
- All oils must be completely dry. Watercolor, Pastels, graphics and some types of Mixed Media must be under glass, unless larger than 24" x 28" and then plexi-glass is required. Frames must be in good repair and ready to hang. **THERE WILL BE NO REPAIR TABLE.**
- All paintings must be framed (gallery wrap 1.5—3" on the edge is acceptable). Use of metal frames is at the risk of the artist. Please see accompanying Professional Framing Standards Flyer. ***Unique or uncommon framing must be okayed by the show chair.*** Screws for hanging must be no more than 4" inches from the top of the frame and the wire must not show over the top of the frame. Please use flat hangers with wires only, no saw-tooth, eyelet hangers or quick frames and no screw eyes. The ends of the wire must be taped or sleeved with plastic.
- The maximum size including frame is 42" x 42", maximum weight 25 lbs. Artists entering sculptures or other 3-D media too large or too heavy to fit on a display table should provide their own pedestal.
- Art may not be removed prior to the close of the show -- 3:00 PM on Sunday, April 24, 2016.
- **Eligibility:** The Old West show is open to all artists 18 years or older Artists under 18 need a parent or guardian's signature on the entry form.
- **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP** entries are arranged by the High Schools. Please contact your High School Art Teacher.
